


## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**CLASS III RECIEVER HITCH APPLICATION:** 2015-2016 Chevrolet Colorado 2015-2016 GMC Canyon **PART NUMBER:** 65-1535

ANTI-SEIZE LUBRICANT MUST BE USED ON ALL STAINLESS STEEL FASTENERS TO PREVENT THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING



### **PROCEDURE**

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Lower the spare tire using the vehicle service tools located in the cab of the truck. Remove the center bracket by removing (4) factory bolts with a 13mm socket. Raise spare tire back into position. See Fig. 1 &2.
- 3. Support the bumper with the two jack stands. Remove (8) factory bolts securing the factory cross member/hitch to the frame rail with a 21mm socket. Set the (8) factory bolts aside for reuse during the hitch assembly installation. (Note: The bumper shares the same mounting points and should be supported from underneath with the two jacks.) See Fig. 3.








- 4. Carefully remove the factory cross member/hitch from vehicle making sure that all wirings clears. See Fig. 3.
- 5. Locate the Hitch Assembly (Item 1) and with assistance align the hitch with the 4 factory threaded holes. Loosely secure the hitch using the (4) factory bolts. Secure the bumper with the factory bolts. See Fig. 4.
- 6. Align and adjust the Hitch Assembly as needed, then fully tighten all hardware at this time. Torque all M14 fasteners to 126 ft-lbs.



## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.

## **FASTENERS**:

All Westin supplied fasteners must be utilized and installed in accordance with the installation instructions and apply torque to the specifications as defined. DOUBLE CHECK ALL FASTENERS BEFORE INITIAL USE, AND PERIODICALLY IN THE FUTURE TO ENSURE PROPER FUNCTION AND SAFETY.

### **DRILLING:**

Most Westin products do not require drilling for installation. If drilling is defined as required, use caution when drilling a vehicle. FAILURE TO REVIEW AN AREA TO BE DRILLED MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR INJURY TO OTHERS AS WELL AS VEHICLE DAMAGE.
