
- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
- 2. Insert the treaded end of the fish wire tool (item 6) into the unibody channel through the bottom mounting hole and feed it out rear channel opening (fig 1 & 2).
- 3. Attach M12 stud plate (item 2) to treaded end of fish wire tool and feed through bottom mounting hole (fig 3).
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for both sides.
- 5. Position the hitch assembly (item 1) on vehicle and attach to the stud plates with the M12 flat washers (item 3), M12 lock washers (item 4), and M12 hex nuts (item 5) (fig 4).
- 6. Insert threaded end of the fish wire tool (item 6) into the unibody channel through the upper mounting holes and feed it out the rear channel opening (fig 5).
- 7. Attach M12 stud plates (item 2) to treaded end of fish wire tool and feed through the upper mounting holes. Repeat for all four upper mounting holes. See (fig 6) for stud plate orientation.
- 8. Attach the hitch assembly to the upper stud plates with the M12 flat washers (item 3), M12 lock washers (item 4), and M12 hex nuts (item 5) (fig 7).
- 9. Level and align hitch assembly and tighten all hardware at this time (fig 8 & 9). Torque M12 hardware to 55 ft-lbs.


Note: Optional electrical bracket mounting holes located on drivers side tab.

Westin Receiver Hitches are designed to accommodate a 2"- square receiver draw bar rated for class III/IV towing. FASTENERS:

All Westin supplied fasteners must be utilized and installed in accordance with the installation instructions and apply torque to the specifications as defined. DOUBLE CHECK ALL FASTENERS BEFORE INITIAL USE, AND PERIODICALLY IN THE FUTURE TO ENSURE PROPER FUNCTION AND SAFETY.

DRILLING:

Most Westin products do not require drilling for installation. If drilling is defined as required, use caution when drilling a vehicle.
