


### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- 1. Lift the front of the vehicle and place the front onto jack stands. Then remove the wheels and tires.
- 2. Remove the bolt from the brake line using a 10mm socket and remove the ABS line from the strut. See Photo 1.
- 3. Disconnect the sway link from the strut using an 18mm socket. See Photo 2.







- 4. Using an 18mm wrench loosen the tie rod end nut. Use a hammer, striking the front of the knuckle boos to unseat the taper. Then remove the nut and remove the tie rod end. **See Photo 3.**
- 5. Remove the (2) lower strut bolts using a 21mm wrench. See Photo 4.




- 6. Remove the (2) bolts from the knuckle. Then lean the knuckle away from the strut. See Photo 5.
- 7. Using a flat tip pry tool remove the retaining clip from the trim panel under the hood. Retain clip. See Photo 6.








8. Using a 10mm wrench remove the (2) bolts in the strut cover. Remove the strut cover. See Photos 7 and 8.



9. Support the strut. Using a 13mm socket remove the (3) bolts in the strut and remove from the vehicle. **See Photos 9 and 10.** 





- 10. Place the new N3 strut into the vehicle and secure using (3) of the supplied 8mm bolts. Hand tighten to secure strut. **See Photo 11.**
- 11. Place the knuckle into the strut and secure by using the (2) OE bolts and nuts tighten using a 21mm wrench. **See Photo 12.**







Place the sway link into the strut and secure using the OE nut. Tighten using a 18mm socket. See Photo 13.
 Place the brake line onto the mount and secure using the OE bolt. Tighten using 10mm wrench. See Photo 14.





- Attach the ABS line to the strut mount and the clip installed in the mounting hole. See Photo 15.
  The top strut bolt hole is slotted for camber adjustment. See Photo 16.
